


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Rear Disk Brake Kit for Honda ATV's

- Do not discard packaging until product has been successfully installed.









Remove components shown: Keep all stock components removed.










Installation: Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.


- 1. Install supplied O-Ring as shown in Fig. 2.
- 2. Install Bearing Housing (F) and Brake Line Bracket (C) with M10 hardware as shown in Figs. 2 2a.
- 3. Install Caliper Mount Plate (E) to Bearing Housing (F) with M10 hardware as shown in Fig. 3.
- 4. Route Cables through Brake Line Bracket (C) as shown in Fig. 4.
- 5. Install Disk Brake Assembly (A). See Fig. 5.
- 6. Secure Cables to Emergency Brake Bracket (D) with stock hardware. See Fig. 6.
- 7. Install Rear Caliper (B) to Caliper Mount Plate (E) with M8 hardware and Spacers as shown in Fig. 7. Spacers install between Rear Caliper (B) and Caliper Mount Plate (E).
- 8. Secure Emergency Brake Bracket (D) to Rear Caliper (B) with provided hardware. See Fig. 7.
- 9. Secure assembly with stock Nut and Cotter Pin. See Fig. 8.
- Tighten all hardware completely.










Loosely connect cables to Emergency Brake Bracket (D) with stock hardware.

- 1.Install M6 x 45 Bolt through "helix screw" until it protrudes approximately 2.5mm.
- 2.Install Emergency Brake Bracket (D) and Helix Screw into Rear Caliper (B) and hand tighten Nut.
- 3.Adjust M6x45 Bolt depth such that the Emergency Brake Bracket (D) is in the correct orientation.
- 4. Tighten Nut up to Emergency Brake Bracket (D).






Spacers install between Rear Caliper (B) and Caliper Mount Plate (E)
